## Paula's Yam Casserole

8 medium yams                      2 pinches of salt  
1 stick butter                      ½ c brown sugar  
½ cup syrup

- simmer yams for 45 minutes or until done. Cool on rack
- remove skins, slice lengthwise, and cover bottom of 9X13 pan with half of yams
- cover with pinch salt, ½ stick butter, ¼ c sugar and ¼ c syrup
- repeat with second layer
- bake at 375 for 30 minutes
